

With Adobe Reader, certification and encryption are designated by a blue banner and black ribbon, which signifies the document has not been modified since issuance and cannot be repudiated. Do not trust the document if any other symbol is displayed







This e-Apostille:


- Only certifies the authenticity of the signature and the capacity of the person who has signed the public document, and, where appropriate, the identity of the seal or stamp which the public official bears.
- Does not certify the content of the document for which it was issued.
- Constitutes an Apostille under the Hague Convention of 5 October 1961 Abolishing the Requirement of Legalisation for Foreign Public Documents only if the Convention is in force between the United States and the country where it is to be presented.
- Complies with the proceedings of the International Forum for the electronic Apostille Programme (e-APP)


- ✓ Contains all the required elements of an **Apostille**
- ✓ Verifies all the same information as paper **Apostille**
- Both documents are contained in a secure tamper-evident file
- ✓ Underlying record can be electronic or scanned copy of hard-copy document
- Completed file with e-App and document transmitted to recipient electronically
- ✓ Entire process takes less than 1 day



A Montana company contracted with the government of South Korea to provide 45 trained forest firefighters during the peak fire season. They needed all personnel to have FBI background checks submitted prior to departure in 30 days.

THE PROCESS:

- Day 1: Employee obtains fingerprints locally
 - ✓ Contractor sends the electronic fingerprint card to the FBI
 - ✓ Electronic FBI report returned to Contractor
- Day 2: FBI file sent to MT SOS for notarization and apostillisation
 - ✓ Completed e-APP returned to Contractor
- Day 3: File sent to South Korea Forest Service and accepted




