### What to Expect

Expect to go home exhausted! The Conference offers over 50 hours of notary education crammed into a day and a half. You can choose the sessions that most closely align with the type of notarial work you perform. The sessions cover everything from the fundamental courses for aspiring notaries, to targeted presentations for online notaries and those who have or want to have notary businesses. Many of the workshops will provide you with hands-on practice on how to perform notarizations; how to identify the type of notarial acts; how to complete certificates.

Expect to be blown away by the amount of knowledge you'll acquire, the people you'll meet, and have a great time doing it.

### What's Included in your Registration Fee?
